***BAND INCOME ACTIVITIES***

After this weekend, the Band Booster Boogie will wind down into a leisurely waltz. We have staffed the Concession Stand for five home games (four of which were back-to-back); planned and coordinated two USSBA Band Competitions; chaperoned the band students to three USSBA Competitions; chaperoned band kids as they "rocked the night away"; and feed 150+ band students on two separate day camps. There are two remaining events: the USSBA Competition in Madisonville, TN on September 30 and the Baltimore Band Trip.



At last spring's budget meeting, the Band Boosters Officers estimated a net income of \$5000 for the October 7th Festival at SDHS. Not only did we hit the target, but we exceeded it by approximately \$500. This is "totally awesome."

For this weekend's competition, we estimated that we would earn \$2500 for our hard work.

For the Concession Stand, we estimated that we would earn \$12,500 for five home games plus several JV and Freshman Games. As it stands now, we are close to our target. After Friday night's game and all the bills have been paid, the grand total can be calculated.

## Fruit & Nut Sale

On October 2, SDHS Band Boosters kicked off the annual Fruit and Nut Sale. We are selling grapefruit, hamlin (juice) oranges, navel oranges and tangelos. A box of fruit sells for \$15. Each box contains about 20-40 navel oranges, 32-50 tangelos, 32-50 hamlins, OR 16-24 red grapefruit. The fruit comes from Riverfront Groves.

The Pecan sale has begun as well. However, we will not have the price of the pecans until about middle of November. The pecans must be picked and packaged before they tell us the cost. Pecans come in 1 lb bags of whole pecan or pieces.

At the beginning of November, each band student will be charged a \$75 Fruit Fair Share charge. This charge was increased from previous years due to the increase transportation costs. For each box of Fruit sold, \$5 will be posted to your child's account to pay the Fruit Fair Share charge. After the initial \$75 is earned, \$5 will be credited to your child's account to pay for other band expenses. In previous years, pecans earned \$1.50 per bag sold. As soon as we learn the cost of the pecans, we can tell you how much will go to Fruit Fair Share.

Fruit money and orders must be turned into Debra Rodery (drodery@sdhsband.org) **NO LATER THAN** November 6. Orders can be turned in directly to Debra at the Band Booster meeting that evening or they can be placed in the band box outside Mr. Chambers office. The expected delivery date for the fruit is December 2. At that time, we will need parents to come out and help check boxes of fruit. Closer to time, we will send out emails with more information and requesting help.

In previous years, the amount of fruit/pecans sold and the amount of money turned in were posted to statements. This year, there will only be one Fruit Fair Share entry charged to statements, and entries pertaining to the amount of Fruit Fair Share received (\$5/box for fruit and \$1.50/bag for pecans). The actual amount of fruit/pecans sold and monies received will be in a separate statement.

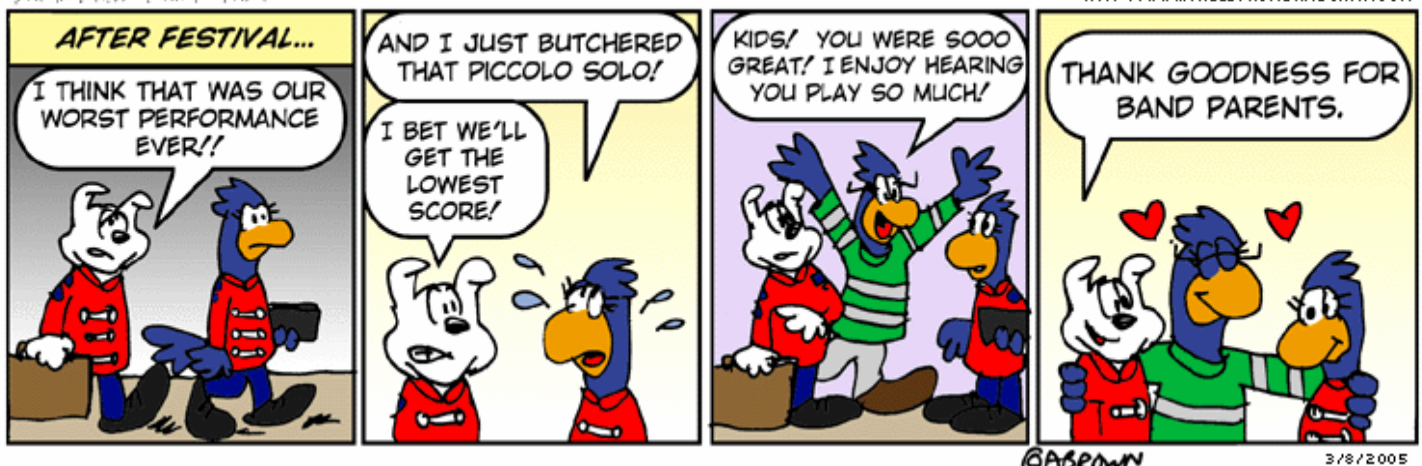
