We need a truck and a driver to help pull the trailers this fall. We have a 12', 20' and a 24' trailer. The larger trailers need a heavy duty truck to pull them. The Fall Football Concession Sectional schedule will be coming soon. Band Camp will be 9-9 with lunch and dinner breaks except Wed (Church night) ends at 4 pm. The Band room will be open at 8:30. The morning session is 9-11:30 Lunch is 11:30-12:30, 12:30-4 (Dinner go home if possible), evening session is 6-9. Lunch can be purchased at the concession stand for \$5.00(to cover our cost.) The combos will be listed on the web page. Mr. Majors announce we will follow the TSSAA Heat Index Rules for the Band. If it is too hot student will be in the AC.
