




December 4, 2015

- 8:15 am Arrive at School
Prepare luggage as it arrives to be loaded.
Prepare instruments, uniforms and guard equipment for loading if not already done.
- 8:30 am Load Buses
When buses arrive, start loading as your chaperone/staff crew instructs.
- 9:00 am Depart School
This is a short trip so there are no scheduled stops.
- 11:30 am Arrive Atlanta, Lunch at CNN Center
Unload at corner of Centennial Olympic Park Drive and Marietta.
Enter into the CNN Center and let the kids eat at the food court. This meal is on their own. There is a lot to explore at the CNN Center, after you finish your meal check out the center.
- 1:00 pm Walking Tour through Centennial Park to World of Coca Cola
