Call to Order

She requested volunteers to help canvas businesses for donations. She has lists of businesses by area and type for anyone willing to help.

<u>Calendar</u> - The 2020 calendar is complete and posted on the website, including winterguard rehearsals, competitions and even summer band camp dates.

<u>Fall Trip</u> - Mr. Light announced that the band will be traveling to the 2021 Outback Bowl in Tampa, Fl. Students will participate in a mass band half-time show, a parade, a field show competition as well as visit Busch Gardens and Clearwater beach. The trip will take place during Hamilton County's winter break from 12/28 - 1/1. Estimated cost is \$1,000 which includes transportation to and from Tampa, 3 nights lodging, and activity entrance fees. Current seniors are eligible to participate. We must have at least 50% participation to go. More information will be coming.

<u>New Uniforms</u> - Joey Whitmire modeled the entire new uniform. Mr. Light explained the different pieces and how each can be worn. He noted that if we raised enough money we could have the new uniforms by August!!
