She also noted that the outside ice machine was not functioning and the ice company would not deliver ice until it is fixed.

City Scope Magazine - Mr. Light highlighted the current edition of City Scope Magazine that had an excellent article on marching bands. SDHS Marching Band and Mr. Light are one of the featured bands and directors.

## **Upcoming Events**

Band Camp - Saturday, September 14th is an all day band camp. The morning session is from 9-12. Students may leave for lunch which is from 12-1:15. The band booster are not providing lunch. The afternoon session is from 1:15-4:00 followed by a 4-6pm dinner break. The evening session will be held in the stadium from 6-9pm. Students taking the ACT are excused from the morning session.

Night Practice - Friday, September 20th is the football by week. The band will have an evening practice in the stadium from 5-10pm.

Homecoming - Friday, September 27th is our Homecoming game against Ooltewah. Alumni are invited to come back and play with the band. During halftime the band will play on the field for the Homecoming court. The show will be performed after the game is over.

Bradley Classic - Saturday, September 28th is our first marching competition at Bradley High School. This is an all day event. More information on the schedule will be released when the date is closer.

IronMan – Sunday, September 29th. Ms. Pruitt talked about the Iron Man and the importance of the aid stations to athletes. She encouraged parents to come and to be inspired not just by the athletes, but by our students. Our aid station is in the same location as previous years, the rowing center on Amnicola. The theme is Star Wars, May the Force Be With You! Students and volunteers are encouraged to come in costume or SDHS clothing. As of this meeting only 10 volunteer slots remained to be filled. Parking is limited and people are encouraged to carpool.
