

WHAT TO WEAR!!!!

LUGGAGE

All travelers may bring 1 suitcase for storage under the bus and 1 standard carry-on (22" x 14" x 9") bag to on the bus with them. **All** medicine needs to be placed in a zip-lock bag with your name on it and turned in to band personnel when you show up at the school for the trip. This will be given back to you on the bus. Remember there is a zero-tolerance policy for drugs/alcohol/tobacco products in the SDHS Band program.

FRIDAY – December 4th, 2015

Morning/Afternoon We will arrive at the school dressed in what we would wear for a normal day around town. We will be riding a bus for a couple of hours, but will also visit the World of Coke and Atlantic Station during this time. You will not have access to your luggage until we check in at the hotel this evening so please plan accordingly.

Evening We will be checking into our hotel this evening and will be provided a snack. Remember that if you are in the public areas of the hotel that school dress code will be enforced.

SATURDAY – December 5th, 2015

Morning/Afternoon We will have our performance this morning. You will need to have your uniform ready for this performance. Students will need to get their uniforms off the trailer when they unload their instruments Friday night. Students will need their BAND SHOW SHIRT to wear under their uniform. Hornline/Drumline marching uniform, Guard uniform from the fall with full makeup. After our performance, students will change out of uniform on the bus to be able to go eat at the Varsity. Color Guard should plan to have wind suits with them during this time as there are no changing facilities between the end of the parade and eating lunch at the Varsity. Students should wear what they plan to wear at the Varsity under their uniform or be able to change into it on the bus. Band shirts and shorts/leggings will be more than appropriate dress for the Varsity.

Evening After eating at the Varsity, students will have a chance to return to the Hotel to change clothes for the evening. We will have our celebration dinner this evening at Six Flags. We will be in the park so please plan accordingly. Theme park at night, might want long sleeves or a coat. The Low Temperature forecast for Saturday night is 36. Roller Coasters get cold riding at night.

SUNDAY – December 6th, 2015

Morning/Afternoon – We will be at Snow Mountain this day. This is real snow! It is wet, cold, and slippery. My suggestion would be to wear warm, water-resistant clothes including gloves and boots. Layering is recommended. We will load the buses from here to travel home. Might want to put something to change into after you get out of the park in your carry-on before you leave the hotel that morning.
